Mission Central: Connecting People and Resources

Mission Central is a nonprofit organization registered with the IRS under section 501c3 and with the PA Bureau of Corporations and Charitable Organizations. It opened in 2002 and was a mission of the Susquehanna Conference of the United Methodist Church. A non-profit corporation since 2020, it retains a close affiliation and partnership with the conference.

Its mission, "Connecting God's Resources with Human Need," has three areas of focus: mission outreach, mission education and disaster response. By partnering with over 180 different organizations, it provides resources to groups doing humanitarian work locally, across the country and around the world. It responds to all weather-related disasters or emergencies that occur.

Mission Central is one of six warehouses that provide the United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR—an organization that provides disaster relief and humanitarian aid to over 80 countries worldwide) with all of their resources used in disaster response efforts. Recently they sent over 11,000 cleaning buckets and more than 45,000 hygiene kits to hurricane-affected areas in the United States, at a value of approximately \$1.5 million. Relief efforts are not limited to UMCOR—over half of the aid provided stays in Pennsylvania.

It is not funded by the United Methodist Church or UMCOR and exists because of the generosity of churches, local businesses and, most importantly, individuals. It costs over \$1,500 daily to keep this warehouse operating.

Following is a recent letter of appreciation.

Thank you, First UMC, Muncy! We are so grateful for your donation. Thanks to your prayers, love and support, we had a record-breaking 2020, assisting over 3.3 million people with over \$10.9 million in resources.

In 2020, some of Mission Central's efforts included:

- distributing over \$780,000 in medical supplies, supporting 241,000 people.
- sending 42 shipments to South America, Africa and Eastern Europe.
- supplying \$433,000 in flood buckets/cleaning kits to recovery efforts.
- launching a school partnership so over 13,000 students and their families received support from Mission Central.

In the first quarter of 2021, we assisted over 1 million people with over \$3.3 million in resources. We are on track for another record-breaking year. We expect needs to increase as the impact of the pandemic continues to be felt.
