Prayer: We Can't Overdo It!

"...pray without ceasing (1 Thessalonians 5:17). Rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, be constant in prayer (Romans 12:12). ...do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God (Philippians 4:6)."

It's hard to overstate the importance of this spiritual discipline for the Christian life. Prayer is simply asking God for help or strength or provision. We should not worry or "be anxious about anything," but bring all our needs and concerns to our gracious Father, because he loves us.

"Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God so that at the proper time he may exalt you, casting all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you (1 Peter 5.6-7)." It is humbling to ask our Father for everything. Prayer says, "Father, I need your help. I need your grace. I need you to provide for me. To give me wisdom and strength. To lead and guide me with my (relationships, finances, work, daily Bible reading and prayer ...)."

Rather than try to solve our own problems or relieve our own anxiety, we should cast them on our Father. Why? Because he cares for us. He genuinely, truly cares for us.

Remember, a discipline is something we do regularly. So don't wait until you're in trouble to pray. Do it every day! A good pattern for prayer is the Lord's Prayer.


