Not enough support for struggling biological, kinship, foster, and adoptive families. Not enough families for kids who need them. But it doesn't have to be that way.

On Sunday, October 3rd, Dwell Orphan Care and First UMC are hosting a foster care advocacy event at which information will be shared regarding the current state of the foster care system in our community and the support needed to ensure that every child in care has a safe, loving, forever home in which to dwell.

If you've ever felt pulled to do more for vulnerable children but you're not quite sure where to start, this event will help provide insight and direction so that you know which step to take first.

Dwell believes that everyone can do something for the cause of caring for foster and adoptive families. Whether it's signing up to foster, providing a meal or buying diapers, offering financial support, praying, mentoring, volunteering, or growing a greater understanding of trauma-informed care, you can find your "something."
