A Life Line screening event will be held in the Celebration Center on January 27, 2022. This screening will consist of a combination of five tests to check for Carotid Artery

Disease, Peripheral Arterial Disease, Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm, Atrial Fibrillation and Osteoporosis Risk. The cost for all five tests in the screening is \$139.00.
