Mission Expo 2022

This year's Mission Expo will be very different than in past years. To begin, the event will take place at the Experience Missions Warehouse at 2117 Marydale Avenue, Williamsport. The event will begin on Monday, October 17th and will run for 2-4 weeks, depending on how long it takes to pack their goal of 150,000 meals. The times available to help pack meals will alternate: Week 1 will be Monday, Wednesday & Friday evenings 5:00 p.m.-8:00 p.m. Week 2 will be Tuesday, Thursday & Saturday mornings 9:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m. Weeks 3 & 4 schedules will be posted on the Experience Missions website if needed.
