### Our Covenant With the Church

People professing their faith for the first time in a United Methodist congregation take two vows dealing with time. As we commit to life as disciples of Christ, among the statements we are asked to agree to are: 1) Be loyal to Christ through the UM Church and do all in our power to strengthen its ministries (The Book of Discipline 2012, ¶ 217.5); and 2) Be faithful participants in its ministries by our prayers, our presence, our gifts, our service and our witness (¶ 217.6).

As we agree to these vows, we commit our lives to Christ and agree to give a significant portion of our time to the ministry that we are called to through our baptism. At year's end, will the activities filling our calendars show us to be good stewards of the time with which God gifts us?

We ask ourselves:

<sup>+</sup> Will the time set for speaking and listening to God be an unbreakable appointment?

<sup>+</sup> Will worship and learning as part of the faith community be a priority?

<sup>+</sup> What will we do/not do to make our money and talents available for ministry?

<sup>+</sup> What will we do outside the church that shows we are disciples of Jesus Christ?

<sup>†</sup> How will we demonstrate the transformational power of the love of Christ?

## **Covenant Prayer—Wesleyan Tradition**

John Wesley and his brother Charles founded the Methodist Movement in England in the 18<sup>th</sup> century. He preached open-air sermons and encouraged his converts to join small groups for prayer, study and moral accountability. Wesley's "Covenant Prayer" (No. 607 in our hymnal) was a key element in his own spiritual discipline and in Methodist discipleship.

I am no longer my own, but yours. Put me to what you will, rank me with whom you will; put me to doing, put me to suffering. Let me be employed by you or laid aside by you, enabled for you or brought low by you. Let me be full, let me be empty. Let me have all things, let me have nothing. I freely and heartily yield all things to your pleasure and disposal.

And now, O glorious and blessed God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, you are mine, and I am yours. So be it. And the covenant which I have made on earth, let it be ratified in heaven. Amen. (posted by Mark Herringshaw, www.belief.net)
