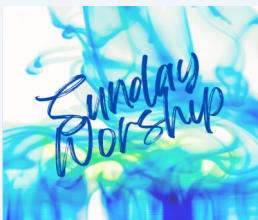
Mission & Outreach Yard Sale—Helpers Needed
